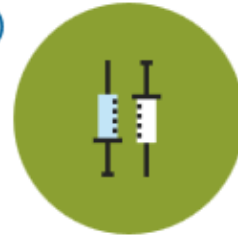


## Map the local impact.

Create different side-by-side state or district maps of opioid use, opioid prescribing, new HIV infections, syringe exchange programs, insurance coverage, and more.

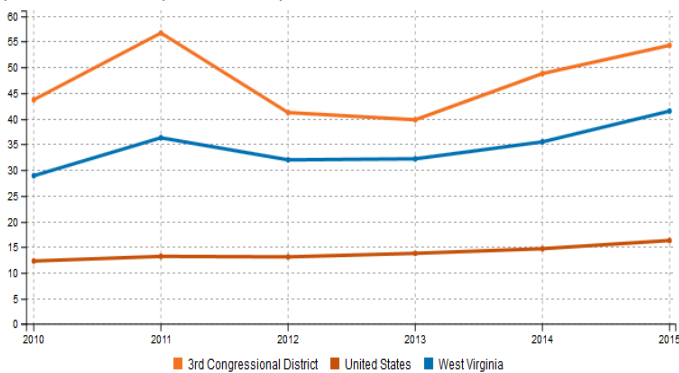
## Explore the policy landscape

Opioid-related Deaths per 100,000 Population



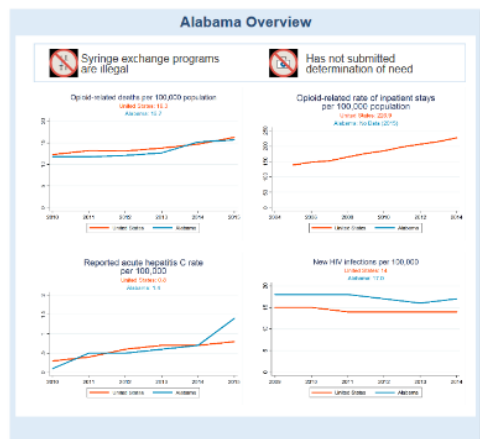
## Monitor local trends

### Opioid & Health Indicators Alabama



In 2016, CDC released a list of counties vulnerable for an HIV outbreak. Of the 220 counties identified in this report, 4 are in Alabama. These high risk counties are Walker County (#237), Marion County (#100), Winston County (#109), and Franklin County (#206).
